DECREE

- 1. Considering the needs of the Archdiocese and in accordance with the practice of the Apostolic See and other dioceses throughout the world, a further proportionate levy is considered appropriate, to be placed upon income gained through extraordinary income received by a parish through the sale of property according to the table at n.6;
- 2. Whereas the Council of Priests was heard regarding this additional levy (cf. n.6) and indicated its favourability on 8 March 2022 (cf. cann 127; 1263);
- 3. Whereas the Archdiocesan Finance Council was heard regarding this same additional levy (cf. n.6) and indicated its favourability on 19 May 2022 (cf. cann. 127; 1263);
- 4. I, the Most Reverend Leo Cushley, Archbishop of St Andrews & Edinburgh, do hereby decree that a levy on income gained by a parish through the sale of property shall be applied according to the table below (cf. n.6), following the provisions of cann. 7; 8, §2; 29; 381; 391;
- 5. I further direct and provide that this law is to be promulgated immediately via the Archdiocesan Website (cf. cann. 7; 8) and;

Sale income after expenses	Levy
£0 to £9,999	0%
£10,000 to £74,999	7%
£75,000 to £149,999	15%
£150,000 to £499,999	25%
£500,000 upwards	29%

7. The foregoing takes effect immediately, all things to the contrary notwithstanding.
