Emma has been the DSA (Diocesan Safeguarding Advisor) since May 2020 and prior to that was the safeguarding officer. She has over 30 years of safeguarding experience from statutory social work services where she was a manager and team leader of Mental Health and Learning disability services. She was also actively involved in **Adult Protection work.** Emma's principal role and duties are to deal with any safeguarding complaints, concerns or allegations that arise within the Archdiocese. Emma also leads on the strategy and development of safeguarding in the Archdiocese.

Elaine has recently joined the Safeguarding Team as the Safequarding Officer. She brings a background of safeguarding through her previous volunteer management and charity sector roles. Elaine previously worked with Alzheimer's Scotland. supporting families coping with dementia, and was an outreach worker for children living with Cystic Fibrosis. Elaine's principal duties are in respect of liaison, support, and advice to the Parish Safeguarding Co-ordinators (PSCs). She will also be involved in Safeguarding Training across the Archdiocese. both Induction Part 1 and 2, PSC training and other training.
