"No," they answered. He said, "Throw your net on the right side of the boat and you will find some." When they did, they were unable to haul the net in because of the large number of fish.

Then the disciple whom Jesus loved said to Peter, "It is the Lord!" As soon as Simon Peter heard him say, "It is the Lord," he wrapped his outer garment around him (for he had taken it off) and jumped into the water. The other disciples followed in the boat, towing the net full of fish, for they were not far from shore, about a hundred yards. When they landed, they saw a fire of burning coals there with fish on it, and some bread.

Jesus said to them, "Bring some of the fish you have just caught." So, Simon Peter climbed back into the boat and dragged the net ashore. 

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


Instructions:

- 3.Glue the cut tissue paper onto the cardboard templates.






Flower Templates

- 5. Glue on the flowers to the outside of the basket.






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The Annunciation - Luke 1: 26 - 38


"How will this be," Mary asked the Angel, "since I am a virgin?"

"I am the Lord's servant," Mary answered. "May your word to me be fulfilled." Then the angel left her.



- Strong glue or sticky tape


Instructions: (assistance from an adult will be needed




