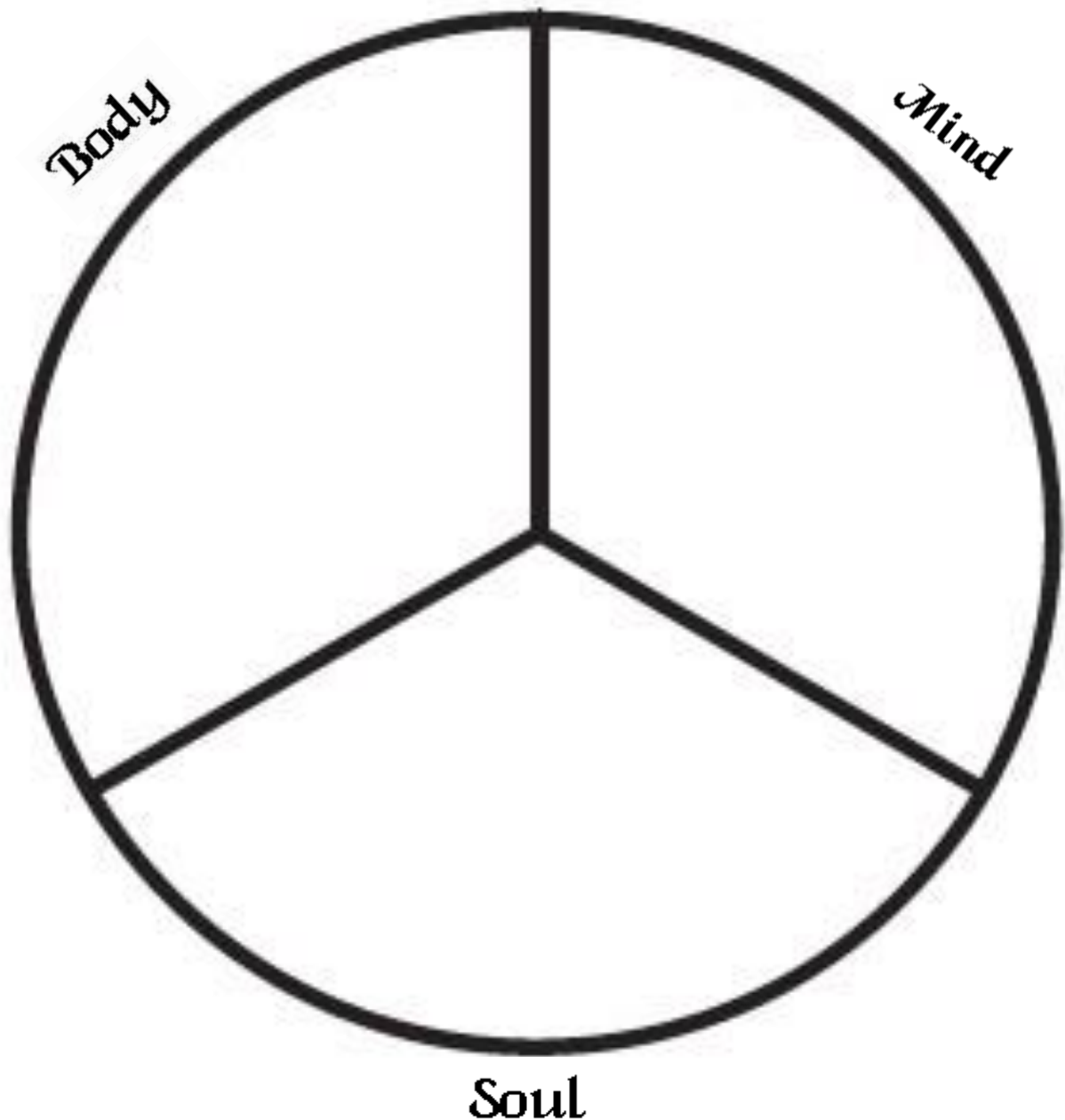


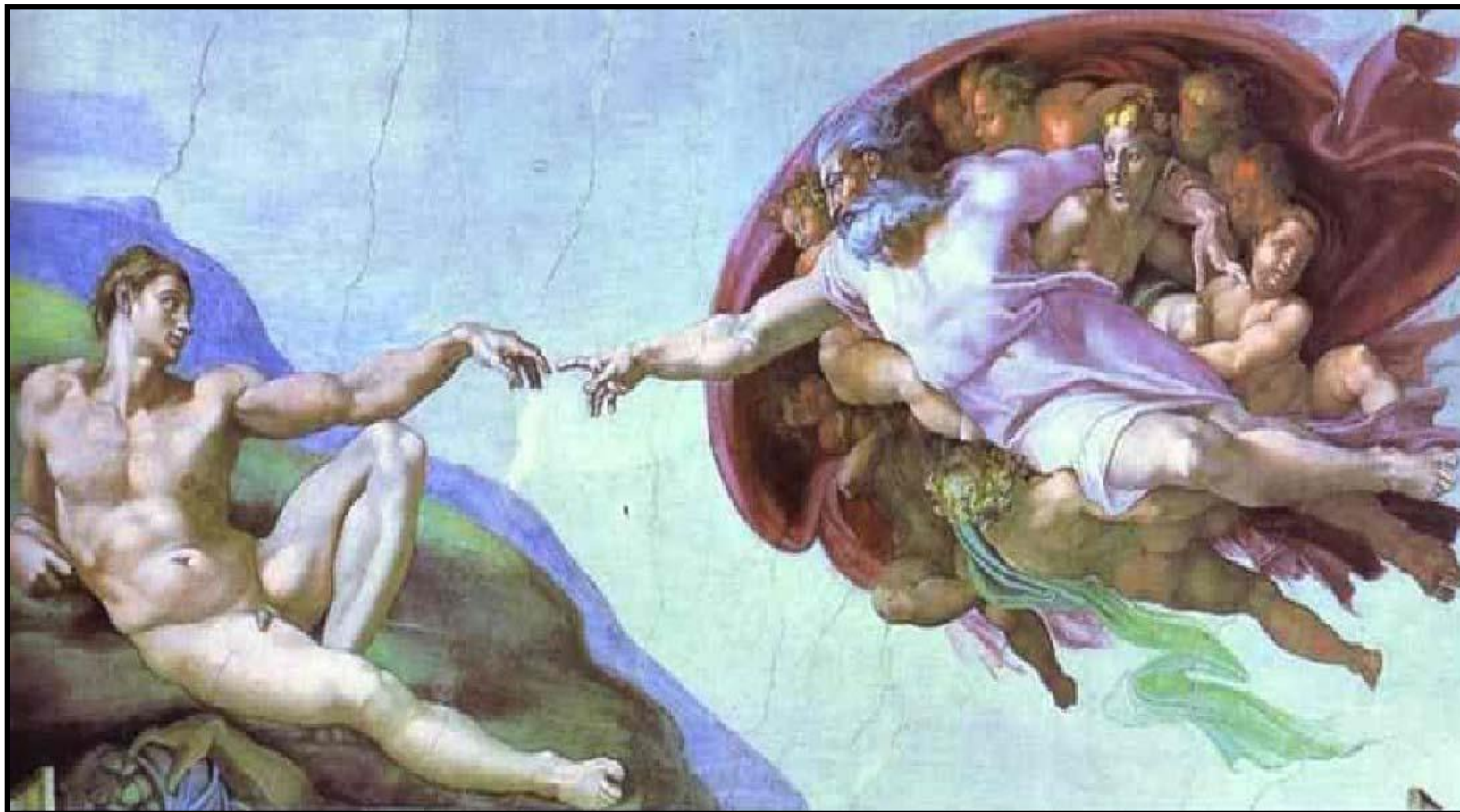
Body, Mind and Soul

Drama Scenarios for Good and Bad Choices

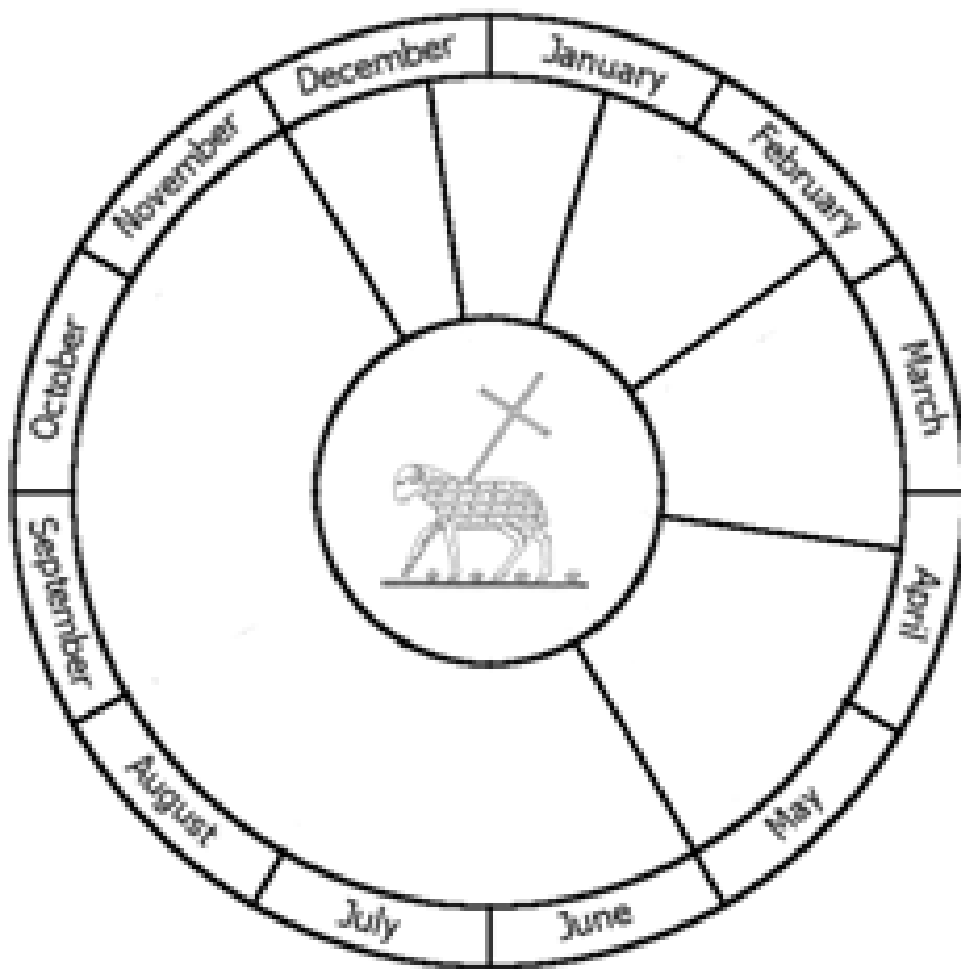
1. You know you are having a multiplication test at school tomorrow. Your friends want you to go out to play with them. What will you do?

Liturgical Colours


Below are six liturgical colours. Match the colours to the descriptions given.



1. _____ is used on days when we celebrate the passion of Jesus on Passion Sunday and Good Friday. It is used for the feasts of the apostles and martyrs. It is also used for the feast of Pentecost and the feasts of the Holy Spirit.
2. _____ is seen everywhere in plants and trees, symbolises life and hope and is used during Ordinary Time.
3. _____ is the colour of joy and it is used for the seasons of Easter and Christmas. It is also used for the feasts of Our Lord, for feasts of Mary, the angels, and for saints who are not martyrs.
4. _____ is for honour and praise. It is sometimes used in place of white, red or green.
5. _____ may be used on the Third Sunday of Advent and on the Fourth Sunday of Lent. It expresses the joy of anticipation for Christmas and Easter.
6. _____ is used during Advent to help us to remember that we are preparing for the coming of Christ. Lent, the season of penance and renewal, also uses this colour.
