SAFEGUARDING WHISTLEBLOWING POLICY

- 1. Where a person has concerns about serious malpractice about the response to a Safeguarding matter within the Archdiocese, they can raise this through the Archdiocesan Safeguarding website or by writing to or emailing, the **Diocesan Safeguarding Advisor.**
- 2. Contact can also be made direct to the Chief Operating Officer.
- 3. Anyone raising concerns can be assured that no one who reports a concern will suffer any detriment for coming forward, regardless of whether the concern is ultimately substantiated. However, deliberately making false or malicious allegations or making a disclosure for personal gain will be treated very seriously and for employees could be a gross misconduct offence.
- 4. Concerns raised will be rigorously and impartially investigated and will be referred to the Diocesan Risk Assessment Management Team if appropriate.
